### MILLE LACS COUNTY DUST CONTROL POLICY

- Mille Lacs County does not provide chloride for dust control. However, Mille Lacs County does allow landowners to purchase chloride on the private market or contract to have it sprayed on a road by private contractors.
- Dust control does not last forever and it does wear out due to traffic, rain, and blading.
- If you notify the Public Works Department before you apply dust control, an effort will be made to reduce blading on that segment of road. However, due to rotation of employees and vacation, we cannot assure that the road won't be bladed by accident.
- It is a judgment call that the road is rough enough that we have to blade the chloride area and we are solely responsible to make that decision.
- By allowing you to place dust control on the road, you are acknowledging that you are doing it at your own risk; and the County has no obligation to reimburse you for materials used, cost of application, or your labor.
- Applications must be **renewed annually**.

I have read the County policy and understand that the County has no responsibility to protect the dust controlled segment of road by reduced blading.
